### **Declaration of Policy**

Sanskriti College's goal is to protect the dignity of laborers, employees, job hopefuls, students, and others obtaining training, teaching, or education. Along with ensuring the full application of the "Fundamental Rights" as stated in sections 14, 15, 19(1)(g), and 21 of the Indian Constitution, it also aspires to ensure complete respect for human rights and the dignity of every individual.

### **OBJECTIVES OF THE POLICY**

- 1. Establish a strategy to prevent sexual harassment and gender-based violence.
- 2. Ensure effective policy communication and implementation through proper grievance reporting and settlement.
- 3. Create a workplace devoid of gender bias.
- 4. Creating a safe and secure environment that discourages inappropriate behavior.

### **Composition of the Anti – Sexual Harassment Committee**

- 1. The committee chair will be a senior female faculty member from the college.
- 2. The committee will include a female class IV staff member, two senior female faculty members, one senior male faculty member, and at least one female administrative staff person.
- 3. Three female students will serve as committee representatives.
- 4. The committee will consist of the principal and one management nominee appointed by the St. Wilfred's Education Society.
- 5. The committee will include a parent of a female college student.
