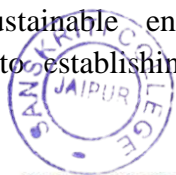
1. Alternate sources of energy and energy conservation measures

2. Management of the Various Types of Degradable and Non- Degradable Waste

In terms of garbage management, Sanskriti College has made great improvement. This was done in an attempt to reduce the environmental damage caused by rubbish and to encourage employees, educators, and students to adopt sustainable habits.

The institution has developed compost pits to address the problem of degradable trash on campus. Compost pits decompose organic waste, such as leftover food and garden detritus. The compost created is used as organic fertilizer in the campus gardens and green spaces.







- ❖ Set up competitions centered on important environmental issues (creation of posters, slogans, essays, creative writing, poetry, street theater, etc.).

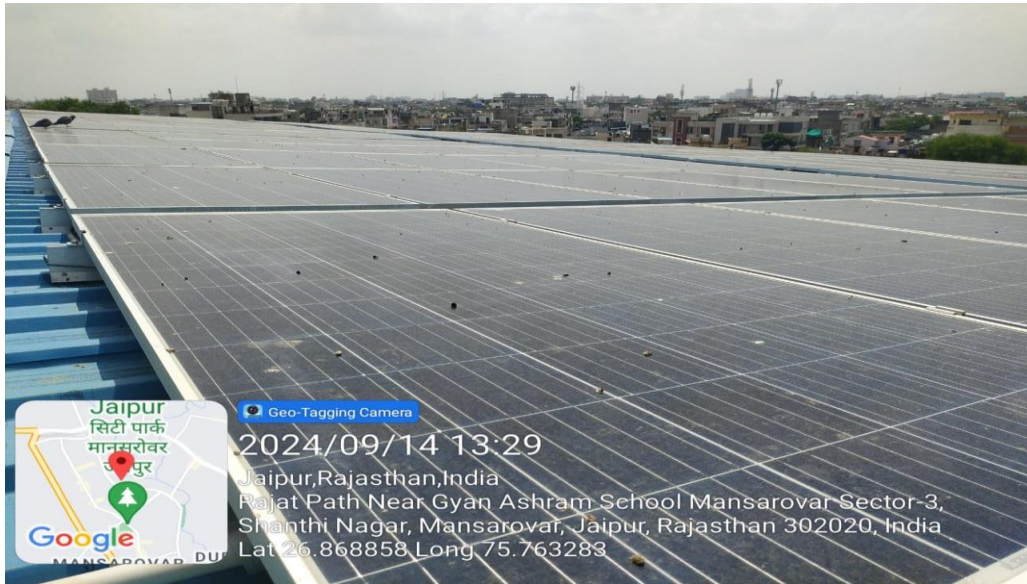
