- 6. **Critical Thinking:** Discussions in groups help individuals develop their critical thinking and argument evaluation skills. They gain the ability to evaluate the merits of many points of view, spot logical fallacies, and have a more sophisticated comprehension of the subject.
- 7. **Teamwork and Collaboration:** Collaborative and teamwork are fostered through group discussions. Interaction, tolerance for differing viewpoints, and group effort toward a common objective are among the skills that participants acquire.
- 8. **Exposure to New Information:** Participants are frequently exposed to new ideas, research, or information during group discussions. Their perspectives are widened, and they are inspired to keep learning.
- 9. **Preparation and Research:** Group discussion participants usually have to do some study on the subject beforehand. This promotes self-initiative and increases participants' subject-matter knowledge.
- 10. **Leadership Skills:** Group discussions give people the chance to assume leadership responsibilities, such as moderating, summarizing, or directing the direction of the discourse This develops one's leadership abilities.


